Reporting Potential Major Liability Losses

In most instances having to do with insurance we report occurrences that we are certain will result in a claim or which we believe are likely to do so (e.g., an automobile accident involving a Bard-owned vehicle, especially when there is an injury).

However, our insurance company has identified specific categories of serious incidents which we <u>must report</u> as soon as possible <u>even if we have no reason to expect that any such</u> <u>occurrence might result in a claim</u>:

- 1) fatality;
- 2) major paralytic conditions such as paraplegia and quadriplegia;
- 3) second or third degree burns to 25% or more of the body;
- 4) amputation, permanent loss of use or permanent loss of sensation of a major extremity;
- 5) head or brain injuries resulting in coma, behavioral disorders, personality changes, seizures, aphasia or permanent disorientation;
- 6) loss of sight in one or both eyes or loss of hearing;
- 7) injury resulting in incontinence of bowel or bladder;
- 8) sexual molestation, sexual assault or rape;
- 9) bodily injury resulting from health care services provided in a clinic, infirmary, student health center, treatment room, or other similar facility that provides medical or health services to students or at other locations in the event of a medical emergency.

Not reporting such incidents could void our insurance coverage should the incident later become a claim.

<u>Please make all potential incident reporters in your areas of responsibility aware of this</u> requirement.

Incident reports should be made to Risk Manager **Fu-Chen Chan** (845-758-7671; <u>chan@bard.edu</u>. She will consult with the VP Admin and our broker to determine whether an occurrence needs to be reported.
