

Scholarship in Literary Arts

Description

The Scholarship in Literary Arts is intended to support students with an outstanding record of involvement and interest in the written and theater arts (e.g. through involvement in school journals and newspapers, publication of original fiction/non-fiction/poetry, or composition/performance of theater pieces). Recipients of the Scholarship in Literary Arts usually demonstrate interest in a Literature and Rhetoric concentration within the B.A. in Humanities, the Arts, and Social Thought program.

Award amount: need-based award up to 20,000 EUR tuition waiver; renewable for up to 4 years

Criteria

Applicants for the Scholarship in Literary Arts must:

- Apply for admission to the Humanities, the Arts, and Social Thought program
- Demonstrate an exceptional record of academic and extracurricular interest in literature and creative or academic writing
- Intend to continue their study of these fields as part of their liberal arts education at Bard College Berlin

The partial tuition waiver is renewable for up to 4 years contingent on the recipient's maintenance of a B average or better.
