

Scholarship in Philosophy, Politics, and Economics

Description

The Scholarship in Philosophy, Politics, and Economics is intended to support students with an exceptional record of involvement and interest in any of these areas. Recipients of this scholarship usually intend to pursue a concentration in one of the B.A. programs.

Award amount: need-based award up to 20,000 EUR tuition waiver; renewable for up to 4 years

Criteria

Applicants for the Scholarship in Philosophy, Politics, and Economics must:

- Apply for admission to one of the B.A. programs
- Demonstrate an exceptional record of academic and extracurricular interest in politics, philosophy, and/or economics.

The partial tuition waiver is renewable for up to 4 years contingent on the recipient's maintenance of a B average or better.
