

## Andrea Luca Mina-Séguin Scholarship

## Description

Founded by BCB Board Member Jacques Séguin and his son Andrea Luca Mina-Séguin, this scholarship supports highly motivated students who achieve a top rating in the BCB Admissions process by demonstrating academic excellence (grades and writing ability), suitability for a liberal arts education, and an interest in the humanities or social sciences. Recipients of the Andrea Luca Mina-Séguin Scholarship will serve as campus ambassadors during their time at the college.

**Award Amount:** Up to the full cost of on-campus room and board; renewable for up to 4 years; this scholarship may be combined with other scholarships and special consideration will be given to students with an outstanding record of civic engagement.

## Criteria

Applicants for the Andrea Luca Mina-Séguin Scholarship must:

- Apply for admission to one of the BA programs
- Be rated at the top of their applicant pool
- Demonstrate financial need

The room and board fee waiver is renewable for up to 4 years contingent on the recipient's maintenance of a B average or better, and residence in on-campus housing.
