Students complete the **Language and Thinking Program** at the beginning of the first semester.

The **Mathematics and Science** module can be completed in any semester, but it is advisable that students complete it before the end of the second year.

Students spend 12-14 hours per week in lectures and seminars, and earn a total of **256 ECTS credits** throughout the four-year program.
