Students wishing to apply for need-based financial aid and scholarships should complete the Student Financial Statement. Please note that Bard College Berlin is able to award financial aid for tuition costs only. The on-campus room and board fee, expenses for academic materials, health insurance, transportation costs etc. will not be subsidized by the College. Therefore in addition to your annual tuition student contribution you need to estimate annual costs of €10,000-€14,000 for housing and living expenses while studying at Bard College Berlin.
