If there are differences, your FAFSA information will be corrected. **You and at least one parent must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Financial Aid Office at Bard.** Bard may ask for additional information. If you have questions about Verification, contact the Financial Aid Office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.
