

United World Colleges Scholarship

Description

The United World Colleges Scholarship is intended to support graduates from one of the 18 United World Colleges who desire to study humanities or social sciences at Bard College Berlin. Successful applicants will have an impressive record of civic engagement in addition to a strong academic record.

Award amount: need-based award up to a full comprehensive fee waiver; renewable for up to 4 years

Criteria

Applicants for the United World Colleges Scholarship must:

- Be a current student at, or a recent graduate of, one of the 18 United World Colleges worldwide
- Apply for admission to one of the B.A. program at Bard College Berlin as an entering first-year student or transfer student
- Demonstrate an exceptional record of civic engagement (for example, through volunteer service, student-initiated projects in their community, or involvement in student government at their school)
- Demonstrate financial need

The full tuition waiver is renewable for up to 4 years contingent on the recipient's maintenance of a B average or better and residence on campus.
