## Scholarship in Art

**Description:** The Scholarship in Art is intended to support talented and dedicated students pursuing the B.A. degree in Artistic Practice and Society. This scholarship aims to recognize individuals with exceptional artistic talent and a strong commitment to using their creative skills to foster positive social change.

**Award amount:** need-based award up to 20,000 EUR tuition waiver; renewable for up to 4 years

## Criteria

Applicants for the Scholarship in Art must:

- Apply for admission to the Artistic Practice and Society program
- Demonstrate an exceptional record of academic and extracurricular interest in the arts (performing arts, studio arts, or audio/visual arts)
- Intend to continue their study of these fields as part of their liberal arts education at Bard College Berlin

The partial tuition waiver is renewable for up to 4 years contingent on the recipient's maintenance of a B average or better.
