- Plastics (#1, #2, #5 Preferred)
- Remember TBJ:
 - Tubs, Bottles, Jars!
- Include Caps & Lids
- Rinse out your containers!


Free-Use



What goes in this bin?

- Clothes & Items that are functional and in *good* condition.
- Art supplies, decor, kitchenware, books, working electronics.
- Anything that is usable that you don't want anymore!

Landfill



What goes in this bin?

- Anything that is not recyclable, reusable, compostable, or E-Waste.


Mixed Paper



What goes in this bin?

- Loose-leaf paper, notes, printer paper
- Thin cardboard
- Newspaper

E-Waste



What goes in this bin?

- Phones, tablets, headphones.
- Non-alkaline batteries (Anything but: A, AA, AAA, AAAA)
