

Cold Call

1. Call on students by using straws/popsicle sticks/etc.
2. Students contribute to discussion as you call their names.

Benefits: Creates an equal playing field for students; essentially the same as your in-class practice

Constraints: Expect awkward pauses if there's a time delay

Hand Raising via Online Tool

1. If you're using a tool such as WebEx, students can "raise their hand" by clicking on the hand. You can then call on students.

Benefits: orderly discussion; students don't speak over or interrupt each other

Constraints: students forget to "unraise" their hand; creates more for you to monitor their participation if you have the participant, chat, and presentation screens going simultaneously
