

Welcome to Bard! If you are eligible to vote, you can either register here on-campus or at your permanent residence. Whichever you choose, Election@Bard is here to help. Follow the instructions below to complete your voter registration form and we will take care of sending it off to the appropriate Board of Elections.

Here are some things to keep in mind:

- Complete this form in **Blue or Black Ink Only**
- Once you've completed the form: Place your Voter Registration Form in an envelope addressed to the Center for Civic Engagement and send it using Campus Mail at the Post-Office in the Campus Center. No need for a stamp! Or, drop it in the Registration Drop-Box at the Center for Civic Engagement Gatehouse.

Instructions (follow along section by section):

1. Don't forget to answer the first two questions about eligibility to vote. You can pre-register in New York from ages 16-18 but won't be able to vote unless you are 18 on Election Day.
2. Write your full legal name.
3. Include your birth date (It is common for people to mistakenly write today's date). Your gender, phone number, and email (Sections 5,6,7) are optional.
4. This is the address where you are going to be registered to vote. If you decide to vote at Bard your address is: **30 Campus Road Annandale-On-Hudson, NY 12504** (double check you got all spelling + numbers correct.)
5. If you are voting at Bard write the above address **INCLUDING** your MSC number (You should have received an email with it). If you decided to vote at your permanent address you can include your Bard Address in this section to make sure you are getting all the appropriate election mail.
6. Completing your Voting History is Optional.
7. If you were previously registered in NY or elsewhere, complete section 12. If you have moved off-campus, include your previous address here.
8. Write in the ID number on your New York State-issued ID or Driver's License. If you don't have either of these, include the last four digits of your Social Security number.
9. Registering with a party is optional but keep in mind you have to be registered with a party to vote in any of their future New York State primaries. If you choose not to register with a party select "No Party." (Keep in mind that the Independence Party is not the same as registering without a party.)
10. Sign and Date Section 16.
