

New York State Absentee Ballot Application Instructions  
Fall Semester 2020

1. Check the reason you are requesting an absentee ballot. If you feel uncomfortable voting in person due to COVID, check off “Temporary Illness”. This is a temporary provision allowed by Governor Cuomo. ([Governor Cuomo signs into Law Sweeping Election Reforms](#))
2. Select “General Election Only”
3. Include Your Full Legal Name
4. Include your Birthdate and the New York State County where you are registered.
5. Include the address where you are registered. If you are registered on campus your address is 30 Campus Road. Annandale-On-Hudson, NY 12504.
6. Do not complete this section. It is for the primary election.
7. Check off “Mail Ballot to Me At” and include your mailing address. If you are registered on Campus your mailing address is 30 Campus Road MSC # \_\_\_\_ PO Box 5000 Annandale-On-Hudson, NY 12504.
8. Print your form and sign and date section 8 in Blue or Black Ink.
9. Deliver Your Absentee Ballot Application to the Bard Center for Civic Engagement. You can send the form through Campus Mail (No Stamp Required) or drop it in the Registration Drop Box outside of the Center for Civic Engagement Gate House. We will take care of delivering them to the appropriate Board of Elections.
