First NY performance in 57 years

Born 3/10/1892 in Le Havre, France **Died** 11/27/1955 at age 63 in Paris

Written 1928, at age 36
Premiered 12/31/1929 at the Colombe Stadium in France during the halftime of a rugby match between France and England

OTHMAR SCHOECK

BURIED ALIVE

Born 9/1/1886 in Brunnen, Switzerland Died 3/8/1957 at age 70 in Zürich

What a rumbling!—Gruesome rolling 4 min
Here I lie now, helpless fellow 3 min
Ha! What is that? 2 min
If I lay in the sand where hyenas roam 1 min
Hark! Voices and yelling 3 min

Died 11/2/1960 at age 64 in Milan

CONCERTO GROSSO

First NY performance in 51 years

Largo (slow and dignified) 4 min Allegro-Largo (fast, then slow and dignified) 3 min Chorale: Largo (slow and dignified) 7 min Allegro (fast) 6 min

Written 1929, at age 33 Premiered 2/27/1930 in Berlin by the Berlin Philharmonic; Mitropoulos conductor

Born 6/18/1882 in Oranienbaum, Russia Died 4/6/1971 at age 88 in New York City
