CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: FALL (Aug/Sept 2022 – Dec 2022/Jan 2022) STUDY MOBILITY OPPORTUNITIES

Program

The OSUN Graduate Mobility Program enables mobility of students between OSUN Institutions. It aims at enabling study and research mobilities for all but strives to promote, in particular, the 'South-South' and 'North-South' exchanges between participating OSUN institutions.

Applications are open for **fall / first semester 2022/23 study mobility** to be completed before January 31, 2023.

Eligibility

Graduate students (Masters and Doctoral level) enrolled at the following institutions can apply to study at another of the listed institutions for the Fall 2022 semester / term in the current round:

The destination of the study mobility can be any of the above listed OSUN member institutions.

Scholarship

The Program offers a combination of merit- and need-based scholarships. The scholarship level depends on the destination. Additional travel stipends are available.

What is covered?

Travel and visa expenses, mandatory insurance, accommodations and living stipend for the duration of the study mobility can be covered.

Applications for fall semester study mobility are due by 23:59 CET (Vienna) on Wednesday, March 30, 2022. Only complete applications will be considered.

Application materials you will be asked to submit include the following for all applicants:

- Filled out application form on [OSUN Application Platform](#) - please sign in using the OSUN login with your institutional e-mail address.
- A letter of motivation for the proposed study mobility
- A list of up to three potential host institutions
- A list of intended coursework for each listed institution
- Up-to-date resume (CV)
- Letter of support from your supervisor / academic program director at your home institution
- Learning Agreement (post-acceptance)

Timeline / Procedure

Applications will be reviewed by a Student Mobility Selection Committee composed of representatives from participating OSUN institutions. All candidates will be notified of the decision by April 30, 2022. Successful candidates will be nominated to their host institution of

choice and will need to fill out the 'non-degree seeking student application' for that institution. Final admission decisions are made by the respective host institution.

A brief follow-up grant report to OSUN Graduate Mobility Programs is due four weeks after the completion of the research mobility visit. The follow-up grant report will include a narrative description of the study mobility outcomes.
